Dear Summit Academy – Toledo Families:

Thank you, families and students, for the hard work and commitment to education you continue to display during the COVID-19 pandemic. These have been such unconventional and uncertain times and your support has been invaluable in seeing our students through them successfully. We have been planning for our second quarter, which runs from October 19 to December 18, with great care. After reviewing multiple scenarios, we have decided to provide our Summit Academy – Toledo families with a combination of remote and in-person learning for the second quarter.

Students will attend school in-person either Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays. The remaining three days will be dedicated fully to remote learning. Summit Academy – Toledo is currently determining educational groups. Those will be announced on October 7 to inform you of your child's schedule. Families who would like to continue their child's learning in a fully remote format for the second quarter can do so. Please notify Summit Academy – Toledo Principal Dawn Heck by October 5 if you prefer a fully remote option for your child.

Summit Academy – Toledo administrative staff and teachers feel it is important to transition slowly back into the building, while considering the social-emotional and academic needs of students. Maximizing safety for students, staff, and families and following Ohio Department of Health and Lucas County Health Department guidelines will remain Summit Academy – Toledo's highest priority in navigating through the upcoming quarter.

During remote teaching periods, teachers and staff will continue to maintain structure in students' school days. One-on-one meetings for students with IEPs, ETRs, and other diagnostics will remain as scheduled. Your student will continue to be served at the highest level. As a school family, we remain committed to doing all we can to ensure the safety of our children, families, and staff.

We will be planning for our third quarter and will notify you of a plan by December 11.
