Dear Summit Academy Families:

I want to thank you and your children personally for the sacrifices, support, and commitments you have made to continue the education process during this difficult period. I also want to express my gratitude to you for sharing your input in our recent survey regarding education delivery for our upcoming third quarter. Nearly 800 Summit Academy families took the survey. For your reference, I am attaching a summary of the survey results at the bottom of this letter.

Our school principals looked at your interests as well as COVID-19 trends and safety guidelines from health agencies in the decision-making process for next quarter, Q3. Similar to what we are did last time we reviewed multiple scenarios and decided to continue with fully remote learning for Q3, which runs from January 5 to March 11, 2021.

Protecting our students, families, and staff remains a top priority. We will continue to follow local, county, and state health department guidelines throughout the pandemic. We will also soon begin planning for our fourth quarter and will notify you of Q4 plans by February 26, 2021. A Q4 survey will be part of that process. We value your input and hope you will participate in that future survey. As promised, here is a summary of results from the Q3 survey:
