Dear Governing Board and School Leader:

As Sponsor of Summit Academy Transition High School Columbus, Buckeye Community Hope Foundation (BCHF) annually produces an End of Year School Performance Report. The goals of this report are to provide you with timely information on your school's performance relative to expectations outlined in the sponsorship contract and to identify areas of strength and those in need of improvement. To that end, the report summarizes school performance in three component areas—academics, compliance (operations and legal), and financial—and provides information about the school's prospect for renewal. This report includes data from the most recent school year and from over the contract term.

Page one of this report includes a summary of the school's performance in meeting its academic, compliance, and financial targets. BCHF calculates an overall performance score in accordance with our renewal policy, which weighs academics more heavily than compliance and finance. Schools that have earned at least 75 percent of their total possible target points have a favorable prospect for renewal; those with less than 75 percent have an unfavorable prospect for renewal. Please note that nothing in this report shall be construed to guarantee renewal or non-renewal of a school contract and that the authority for renewal decisions lies with the BCHF Board of Trustees.

The rest of the report provides detailed performance data in academics, compliance, and finance. The compliance and finance targets are two points. Schools may earn less than two points for failing to meet the target. The academic target is three points and schools may earn greater or less than the target. The performance detail score at the top of each component area (academics, compliance, and finance) summarizes what percent of applicable target points a school earned in that specific area.

More information about the targets and metrics can be found in the Performance Framework, located in Exhibit 3 of your sponsorship contract. BCHF representatives will also discuss this report at an upcoming governing authority meeting of your school. Should you have additional questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Finally, please note that, in accordance with Ohio law, BCHF submits a written report of the performance of our portfolio of schools to the Department of Education and Workforce by November 30 of each year. We also make this report available to parents and guardians of the students enrolled in our sponsored schools.

Prospect for Renewal

The BCHF Board of Trustees makes evidence-based renewal decisions in accordance with our renewal policy. Currently Summit Academy Transition High School Columbus's prospect for renewal is unfavorable.

Academic:

Summit Academy Transition High School Columbus earned 66.7% of the applicable academic points possible. This represents 50% of the final overall score.

Summit Academy Transition High School Columbus should focus improvement efforts on areas of need noted in the academic rubric. The school should also maintain or further improve upon areas in the rubric rated as meets the target.

Compliance:

Summit Academy Transition High School Columbus earned 100% of the applicable compliance points possible. This represents 25% of the final overall score.

Financial:

Summit Academy Transition High School Columbus earned 62.5% of the applicable financial points possible. This represents 25% of the final overall score.


